

A Report of MAHAK's Activities for Childhood Cancer Awareness Month 2020









CEO Message

The rate of childhood cancer is significantly rising around the globe and this growth is considerably higher in LMICs where 80% of all childhood cancer incidences are reported.

Limited financial resources, lack of national registries, late diagnosis, limited access to quality medicine, refusal and abandonment of therapy, and a collection of socioeconomic, environmental, cultural and educational barriers are among the causes which highlight the necessity to devise a universal plan for LMICs. Recently, programs such as WHO's Global Initiative for Childhood Cancer have been enacted by policy making organizations striving to increase the cancer-stricken children's survival rate in LMICs. MAHAK as an active member in the regional board of CCI has been provided with the opportunity to benefit from this program. It should be noted that childhood cancers are not preventable; accordingly, the fact that can ease, facilitate and accelerate treatment process is to decrease the diagnosis-to-treatment interval which will be only realized through raising awareness about this disease among different different strata of the society especially among children related groups. Professional organizations along with the community-based ones which have emerged to fulfill a societal need have an important role and responsibility in this regard.

In this line, MAHAK as the only center active in three fields of treatment and support care as well as cancer research in Iran has always strived to raise awareness in the society about childhood cancer by conducting various campaigns through the course of the year including the World Cancer Day (February 4) and International Childhood Cancer Day (February 15) as well as MAHAK's Cancer-Survivors Day (December 27 in MAHAK calendar). At the invitation of esteemed organizations of CCI and SIOP, this year MAHAK has added Childhood Cancer Awareness Month (CCAM) to this series of occasions for awareness-raising in order to inform a greater number of people about this disease.

We hope that these activities will alert the society about childhood cancer and will result in higher survival rate of pediatric cancer all over the globe and ultimately in having a more effective, less painful and less expensive treatment.






